Senate Bill 456 passed in 2013 **□NC** statute 131E-78.5 **□** Designates Primary Stroke Centers □Enabled the Department to adopt rules to implement the designation Stroke Center Designation Rules - effective in 2015 □10A NCAC 14L .0101 (Definitions) and 10A NCAC 14L. 0201 (Requirements) □Includes Primary Stroke Centers, Comprehensive Stroke Centers and Acute Stroke Ready Hospitals in the designation

 Add Thrombectomy-Capable Stoke Centers to the state designation (via legislation)
