


Key Focus

In-Clinic Pharmacist Pilot (ICPP)

Community pharmacists are embedded in clinics to work with care teams within census tracts in SC to provide education and training for controlling hypertension and addressing related cardiovascular disease.

Supported by South Carolina Office of Rural Health (SCORH) and Donna Avant, a distinguished Community Pharmacist.

Adaptation of SC Pharmacy Association patient education program.

- Foothills Community Health Care (a FQHC) in Anderson Co., SC.
- Over 30 patients enrolled as of April 2025

Interdisciplinary ECHO Series(IES)

- Launched in June 2024, offering solutions to resistant and complex HTN and CVD cases for primary care and other providers with recommendations from clinical and community subject matter experts (SMEs)
- * Reoccurring monthly, 1-hour sessions
- * "All teach, All Learn"
- Free CME credits are offered to participants*
- → Community-Clinical Linkages

Constellation Regional Learning Collaborative (CRLC)

A primary care, team-focused, hypertension improvement program that launched in July 2024 with education modules designed to help the practice meet the goals and outcome measures.

- One-year collaborative
- Offered annually
- → Quarterly SME-led learning sessions
- Continuous support of Lead and Transformational Coaches

- Practices follow guidance from change packet
- ★ Community-clinical linkages engaged
- Free CME credits are offered to participating care team members*
- Upon successful completion, practices receive American Society of Hypertension (ASH) designation

- Powered by Vega
 - A bi-directional referral platform
- → Supported by a HUB CHW Navigator
 - Personalized Care Coordination
 - Bi-Directional Referrals via Vega
 - Health Education and Support
 - Culturally Competent Assistance
 - Ensuring Continuity of Care
- → SDoH screenings completed with PRAPARE tool
- ↑ Launched November 2024
